Dallas Tag Policy

Issue Date: Oct 31, 2009. Effective 2010

Dallas Tags:

What are they for? The Dallas tags are used for members to gain entry into the front door to the squash club, to turn on the lights for the courts, to gain access to the club online court booking computer and the club office door. Access and entry to these areas can be enabled or disabled for each individual tag.

Issue of Dallas Tags:

Every club member will be issued a Dallas tag (\$20.00 for the tag). This tag will be issued to the members name and the individual number for the tag will be recorded in the club membership registry.

Member Responsibility.

Each member is responsible for their issued Dallas tag. The tag is for their use only and is not to be shared with other individuals so they may gain access to the club. Violations of this can lead to loss of access rights to removal from the club.

Club Member Rights on the Dallas Tags.

Front Door: All current financial members will have access.

Court Booking Cabinet: All current financial members will have access.

Club Office Door: All current committee members, current interclub captains.

Courts: All current financial members will have general activation for the courts
(General Activation: Tag shows their name, they need a second tag to get lights to turn on)

Visitors: All current financial members will get the ability to have visitors. If they fail to pay the visitor fee, this ability can and may be revoked.

Practice: Practice will only be granted to current financial club members who request to the committee. Restrictions may apply.

Override: Only current committee members will have override. Current Members can request to the committee. An override key will be provided in the office for interclub captains to use.
